Elements of a Salvation History Psalm  
(Telling Your Story of Faith)

1. Tell \_\_\_\_\_.

"I will utter hidden things, things from of old - what we have heard and known, what our fathers have told us." (Ps 78:2-3)

2. Tell \_\_\_\_\_.

"We will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done." (Ps 78:4)

3. Tell \_\_\_\_\_.

"Then they would put their trust in God and would not forget his deeds but would keep his commands." (Ps 78:7)
